

Measures Taken in Study at Ease Project

Cases	Measures Taken
1. Course Selection	<p>(1) Online course selection: August 29 - September 2, September 5 to 9, September 12-16,2022. Manual course selection will be done only if one is not able to do so online.</p> <p>(2) If the student needs to be quarantined or require medical assistance after the school semester begins, he/she can apply to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- reduce the number of minimum required credits before September 16, 2022- dropping courses before Oct 14, 2022, or withdraw courses between November 7 to December 2,2022.
2. Tuition Fee Paying	<p>(1) Student should pay their tuition fee through any methods such as by convenient store, ATM transaction and others between Aug 26~ September 19. If you want to pay by credit card, you should make it before September 30.</p> <p>(2) Student with any special case can apply for tuition fee waiver by providing a prove and application form.</p>
3. Courses Attending	<p>(1) Students who couldn't arrive school on time should fill in "Application Form of Study at Ease Project" and email to registra@dragon.nchu.edu.tw. The school/teachers will try to upload the learning material to iLearning website.</p> <p>(2) The online courses needed to be approved by school in the later meeting to insure the quality of teaching.</p>

4. Exams and Grades	<p>If a student cannot attend exams due to the COVID-19 pandemic, they can take leave on the online system (https://reurl.cc/M7ezbX) and provide proof. Make-up exams or other measurements will be organized.</p>
5. Taking a Leave	<p>Students who are unable to attend courses due to the COVID-19 pandemic should take leave on the online system (https://reurl.cc/M7ezbX), and provide proof.</p>
6. Temporary Suspension, Drop-out, or Resumption from the University	<p>Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, students may:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Apply for Temporary Suspension: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - please apply for “Study at Ease Project” (email to registra@dragon.nchu.edu.tw), and apply for Temporary Suspension (the extended years of suspension will not accumulate beyond the maximum years of suspension). - Tuition Fee Refund: Tuition fees will be fully refunded to students. (2) Academic Counseling for Resuming Students: The University will provide necessary assistance to students who resume after Temporary Suspension due to COVID-19. (3) Extend the Length of the Students’ Degree Program : Any Temporary Suspension due to COVID-19 will not be accumulated beyond the maximum number of years for graduation.
7. Graduation Requirements	<p>Graduation credits requirement: Each department could adjust their courses’ contents/hours depending on the course types.</p>
8. Other Rights	<p>Students’ rights such as participating in a dual degree, an exchange program abroad, an internship program and an Industry-University cooperation program, will be reserved if affected by this pandemic situation.</p>
9. Counseling and Support	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Case Following: OIA will follow up any cases and provide help to students who are in need. (2) Privacy: all the process will be done by regulation and the individual privacy will be protected.
