My name is Savadogo Adama Wendtongo Cheick Tidiane, I'm from Burkina Faso and I'm second year Mechanical engineering Student at National Chung Hsing University (NCHU). I arrived in Taiwan two years ago in September and I immediately started learning Chinese at MingChuan University in Taipei.
