Benefits	 Tuition waiver (The fees of mandatory insurance and accommodation are not included. Students need to pay both fees by themselves.) Monthly stipend will be offered upon budget availability and qualification of students. [Note] Benefits only apply to the nominees that fall within the agreed quota of the partner university agreement.
