Benefits	<ol> <li>Tuition waiver (The fees of mandatory insurance and accommodation are not included. Students need to pay both fees by themselves.)</li> <li>Monthly stipend will be offered upon budget availability and qualification of students.</li> <li>[Note] Benefits only apply to the nominees that fall within the agreed quota of the partner university agreement.</li> </ol>
