

- 5. Please update the e-mail in the system for course selection for avoiding missing important information.
- 6. Only one PE course per semester can be chosen for the freshman and sophomore years, and one service-learning course per semester can be chosen for the freshman year only.
- 7. Undergraduate students in the freshman, sophomore, and junior years need to take at least 16 credits per semester to be a full-time registered student.

Remarks:

- 1. All courses addition/removal are **ON-LINE**. The online course selection system will be closed temporarily from 8:00 am to 10:00 am during the course selection time due to maintenance.
- 2. Please follow the schedule for course selection and check the chosen courses online. The result of course selection is based on the record of online system.
- 3. Masters and doctors can choose undergraduate courses during the stage of Course Add-in & Drop Online.
- 4. According to the Article 21 The NCHU Student Study Regulation, graduate students should choose at least one course (including Dissertation) in every semester to be a registered student.
- According to the Article 35 The NCHU Student Study Regulation, students should complete the course selections in the request period. Students who fail to do so will be suspended from school for the current semester.

Free Chinese courses

Studying in Taiwan provides an excellent opportunity to learn Chinese, and National Chung Hsing University offers three types of free Chinese courses to help students enhance their language skills and immerse themselves in the local culture.

一、College Chinese 大學國文- 2 hours per week

Class for Overseas and International students (Code 1751 \, 1752)

College Chinese is a compulsory course for all undergraduate students, except English-taught programs. These classes offer a comprehensive exploration of Taiwanese culture and literature, enhancing students' language proficiency in reading, writing, and comprehension.

二、Practical Chinese 實用華語 -3 hours per week

Practical Chinese is for international students who wish to learn or improve their Chinese language skills. Classes are available with four levels during the day-time course and evening course to meet all students' needs.

Intensive Chinese courses

For those looking for a more intense schedule, the <u>Chinese Language Center</u> offers courses of 15 hours per week with discounts for NCHU students.

Information about Taking "Practical Chinese" course

- MUST
- 1. According to the criteria of each department, freshmen will need to take 4 credits of **College Chinese before graduating.**
- 2. "Practical Chinese" can help with building up Chinese ability and offers 3 credits per course.
- 3. PLACEMENT TEST is for international students who need 'Practical Chinese' courses, and the link for this test will be sent by the language center on July 19th. The test is scheduled to take place between July 22nd and August 2nd.
- 4. Students who prefer **Evening** 'Practical Chinese' courses must sign up for their courses in person at the language centers. Those preferring courses at other times can choose their course online during course selection according to the result of placement test.

NEW1. Micro courses in professional fields have been provided since the 1st Semester of the 2023 Academic Year. Please click "other search items" - "Classification" - "micro courses in professional fields"

NEW2. The language "Chinese/English" means that the instructor teaches in Chinese and English in class, and the teaching materials and assessment methods are all in English.

NEW3.English/EMI refers to teaching content, academic/teaching materials, evaluation and presentation of learning outcome, and the interaction between teachers and students in the classroom are in English. The communication among students can be in Chinese with a ratio lower than 30% of the whole course.

4.Click "Class Number" to check the course outline and office hours.

5.The word "etc." in "Instructor field" means a teaching group. Please place the mouse (do not hold down) in the teacher's name, and you can see the teaching group of the course.

6.The first code of "class time" represents "day of the week", and the rest represent "sessions". The detailed time is as follows:
