Mobility options at TU Graz for NCHU students

overSEAs Programme Semester Exchange

Duration: 1 or 2 semesters

Exchange semester: attend courses (credit bearing)

No tuition fees at TU Graz

Take German Classes

Welcome events and networking/cultural activities during semester

Summer schools and summer programmes

Duration: depending on the programme (5 days up to 2 month)

Attandance of summer programme (certificate of participation)

Advantages of an exchange at TU Graz (1/2)

- For taking classes no German is required!
- 30% of regular classes taught in English
 - 19 Bachelor's programmes with German and English courses
 - 34 Master's programmes (of which 17 are completely taught in English)
- Bachelor (undergraduate) students are allowed to take Master (graduate) courses if advanced in their studies
- Choose courses from different majors and fields of study



Advantages of an exchange at TU Graz (2/2)

- Possibility to also select courses from other universities in Graz (e.g. Uni Graz)
- Support and advice from International Office before, during and after exchange
- Many practical projects with companies and industrial partners


