Kasetsart University Institute for Advanced Studies (KUIAS) Application Announcement for the Reinventing University Program, Kasetsart University 2022 Activity 2.2 Visiting Postdoctoral

Kasetsart University continues to foster innovation by encouraging its faculty and researchers to engage in collaborative research, to produce high-quality outcomes, and to publish their research findings in top-ranked international academic journals.

The focus of this endeavor is broad. KUIAS seeks to promote research in the fields of agriculture and forestry (including agriculture, agro-industry, fisheries, forestry, environment, veterinary medicines) and related fields (including engineering and natural sciences) by building a research ecosystem which has a deep foundation in technology and the sciences, leading to frontier research.

Accordingly, Kasetsart University Institute for Advanced Studies (KUIAS) is now calling for foreign postdoctoral fellows to co-apply, with a KU faculty member or researcher, as an Activity 2.2 Visiting Postdoctoral, under the Reinventing University Program 2022.

1. Eligibility Criteria

1.1 Only a KU faculty member or researcher is eligible to apply as **host** for an Activity 2.2 Visiting Postdoctoral

1.2 The host must have:

1.2.1 Scopus H-index \geq 8, or

1.2.2 Research publications within the past 6 years (2016 to present) that are classified in Scimago Journal Rankings Q1 or Q2

- at least 1 publication in the field of Agriculture and Forestry, or

- at least 3 publications in other related fields

1.2.3 completed the "RI 2-1 KU Host Professor" application form.

1.3 The **postdoctoral fellow candidate** must be a foreign person (only non-Thai citizens are eligible) and must have least 1 research publication within the past 6 years (2016 to present)

- as first author or corresponding author that is classified in Scimago Journal Rankings Q1 or Q2, and

- must complete the "RI 2-2 Visiting Postdoctoral" application form.

1.4 Activity 2.2 Visiting Postdoctoral should be scheduled to occur between June 2022 and May 2023.

2. Allocation

2.1 The maximum funding allocation for a foreign postdoctoral fellow is 45,000 THB per month, for a maximum period of 12 months.

2.2 The maximum travel allocation provided to a foreign postdoctoral fellow who is selected to conduct the research at Kasetsart University is 50,000 THB per person (reimbursement for actual expenses as evidenced by approved receipts).

3. Outputs

The host must submit evidence of at least 2 co-research publications, with the foreign postdoctoral fellow as first author, Kasetsart University as affiliation, and a KU faculty member or researcher as corresponding author:

1. At least 1 research publication classified in Scimago Journal Rankings Q1 in the field of Agriculture and Forestry or related field, and

2. At least 1 research publication classified in Scimago Journal Rankings Q1 or Q2 in the field of Agriculture and Forestry or related field.

Acknowledgements in the publications shall read:

This work was financially supported by the Office of the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation; and by the Thailand Science Research and Innovation Project, under the Kasetsart University Reinventing University Program 2022.

3. At least 1 research work must be published within 12 months following completion of the research activity.

4. Research works published under *Clause 3. Outputs* must adhere to the procedures set forth in *Kasetsart University Regulations on Research Grant Administration B.E.* 2562.

4. Visa Arrangement

The **host** has the responsibility to assist with preparing the documents needed by the postdoctoral fellow to obtain the Non-Immigrant Type-B visa and work permit, working in coordination with KU's International Affairs Division or other agencies.

5. Application Procedures

- 5.1 Dateline for application is 20 May 2022 (Friday)
- 5.2 The host must complete the "RI 2-1 KU Host Professor" application form. The postdoctoral fellow candidate must complete the "RI 2-2 Visiting Postdoctoral" application form.
