ADMISSIONS

Application Period

January 1, 2022 ~ May 20, 2022 (Early-bird : ~March 31, 2022)

Eligibility

You are eligible to apply for if you:


- are currently enrolled in university-level (or higher) institution
- hold a degree from a university-level (or higher) program
- are admitted to a university-level institution

Required Documents

- Copy of Passport: A legible photocopy in JPG or PDF Format
- Academic Transcript: A certified version from home institution (Must include Name, Student ID, University logo)
- Insurance: All students must have an international travel insurance which covers medical expenses during the program. Proof of Insurance must be submitted up to 2 weeks before the start of program.
 - *Korean National can replace the health insurance with 국민건강보험

Visa

- Students coming from a visa-waiver country: Apply for K-ETA
- Students coming from countries that do not have a visa-waiver agreement with Korea must apply for a Short-term Study Visa (D-2-8)
