The "Agricultural Exploration: Cultivating Memories" program, organized by the National University of Science and Technology (NUST), is a unique educational experience designed to immerse students in Taiwan's rich agricultural traditions while fostering an appreciation for sustainability. The three-day, two-night event combines hands-on activities with cultural exploration, giving participants a comprehensive look into Taiwan's farming practices, tea culture, and local history.

The adventure begins with a visit to Lugu Township, a lush, fertile agricultural region in Taiwan renowned for its high-quality tea production and sustainable farming practices. Here, participants are introduced to local farmers who share their knowledge and expertise on innovative techniques used in agriculture today. Students have the chance to observe the implementation of sustainable methods, learning how these techniques are critical in ensuring the long-term health of the environment. By engaging directly with these farming practices, the students gain a deeper understanding of the balance required between agricultural productivity and environmental responsibility.

After the visit to Lugu Township, the exploration continues to one of Taiwan's most famous natural landmarks: Sun Moon Lake. This iconic destination not only offers breathtaking views but also plays a key role in Taiwan's tea-making industry. At the HOHOCHA Tea Plantation, students dive into the world of tea-making, learning the intricate processes involved in tea cultivation, harvesting, and production. The hands-on experience allows participants to see the full cycle of tea production, from the moment the leaves are picked to the final preparation of the tea. In addition, the plantation visit highlights the cultural importance of tea in Taiwan, making it not just an agricultural product, but also a symbol of tradition and hospitality.
